Information for Year 7 Academic Year 2021/2022

1. What should I do if the local authority has offered a place to my daughter?

If your daughter has been offered a place at CCHSG please do not contact us at this stage. The school will be writing to you within two to three weeks of National Offer Day asking you to complete and return our acceptance form.

2. What should I do if my daughter has not been offered a place at CCHSG?

If you did not get your preferred school, you will be added to the waiting lists of all schools that were ranked higher than the school offered in your application. You will be notified in writing if an offer is available. Essex County Council hold the waiting lists for all schools until 31 August 2021. You will be unable to contact Essex County Council until 15 March 2021 with regard to the waiting list. CCHSG will be unable to give you any information regarding waiting list positions until after this time.



3. Travel

4. What if I would like to change my choice of school?

Contact the School Admissions team at Essex County Council admissions@essex.gov.uk if you:

- want to apply for a school that you did not apply for originally
- wish to be added to the waiting lists for a school that you named as a lower preference on your application than the school offered.
- You should not reject the school offer you have until you have secured another place.
