7	Greek Art: Listen to podcasts, watch Youtube videos related to the module. Make notes as you do so.
8	Greek Religion: Make mind maps for each of the topics without using your notes. Go back and add to them in another colour pen.
9	Greek Religion: Use Google Scholar / Jstor to find secondary scholarships. Add it to your tables.
10	Greek Religion: Listen to podcasts, watch Youtube videos related to the module. Make notes as you do so.
11	Greek Religion: Read the Homeric Hymns and Hesiod, make summary notes, including key themes.
12	General: Practice 10 mark stimulus questions by selecting a passage of text / prescribed source. and annotating it. Then, write the 10 marker.
13	General: Reattempt key components of a poorly executed exam in exam conditions - either same question or mirror questions
14	General: Plan and write past paper questions. Purple pen your essay with tips from the markscheme
15	Greek Art: Annotate blank copies of art from the Greek Art module without looking at notes. Add to them in another colour using your notes
16	Visit the British Museum and find the artefacts you study, write notes on what the museum says about them to supplement your class notes
