	Proactive Independent Study Menu
1	Language: Make vocabulary flash cards for both verse and prose unseen translations or use quizlet / interactive websites to practice your vocabulary.
2	Language: Pick a theme ie. parts of the body or family and write down as many Latin words as you can think of connected to that theme. Then, think of some in English and look them up in Latin.
3	Language: Practise writing out your noun and verb tables.
4	Language: Pick an unseen. Go through it word by word and explain all of the grammar connected to that word,
5	Scansion / Language: Pick an unseen. Try to scan it.
6	Language: Using an unseen, set yourself comprehension questions to answer. Focus on cases, uses of the subjunctive, present active infinitives and parts of verbs.
7	Literature: Write a plot summary for your set texts.
8	Literature: Compile a list of themes and evidence for your set texts.
9	Literature: Select a passage from your text, Plan or write a possible 15 marker.
10	Literature: Plan or write possible 20 markers - consider THEMES.
11	Literature: Search for Youtube videos of your set texts. Make notes as you watch them.
12	Literature: Using a blank copy of your set text. Try and translate / analyse it without your notes. Go back and correct your work using your notes from class.
13	Scansion: Write out all the rules of scansion you can remember. Go back and add the ones you have missed using your notes.
