**What is Redemptoris Missio?**

**An encyclical by Pope John Paul II outlining the Catholic Church's missionary objectives, including inter-faith cooperation.**

**What is the Church of England's "Sharing the Gospel of Salvation"?**

**A document discussing how Christians can engage in respectful dialogue with people of other faiths while sharing their own beliefs.**

**What are the aims of inter-faith dialogue?**

**To promote understanding, reduce conflict, and foster social cohesion while respecting distinct religious identities.**

**What is social cohesion?**

**The ability of a society to live harmoniously and inclusively, despite differences in culture, religion, or ethnicity.**

**What are sacred texts?**

**Migration introduces people of different religions and cultures into new regions, increasing diversity.**

**It helps participants understand different religious truth claims and reduces misconceptions.**

**What is the main goal of scriptural reasoning?**

**To foster deeper inter-religious understanding and respect without requiring agreement.**

**It reduces prejudice, promotes peace, and strengthens community relationships.**
