<b>What is exclusivism?</b>	<b>Exclusivism is the belief that only one religion, such as Christianity, is the true path to God and salvation.</b>
<b>What is inclusivism?</b>	<b>Inclusivism holds that while Christianity is the normative means of salvation, people of other faiths may also achieve salvation through Christ, even if they do not explicitly acknowledge Him.</b>
<b>What is pluralism?</b>	<b>Pluralism is the belief that there are many valid paths to salvation and that no single religion holds a monopoly on truth.</b>
<b>What is meant by 'anonymous Christians'?</b>	<b>'Anonymous Christians' refers to people who live according to Christian principles and values, even if they do not explicitly identify as Christians.</b>

**What is the view of Hick on religious pluralism?**

**John Hick argued that all religions provide a means to salvation, each offering a different perspective on the same ultimate reality.**

**What did Karl Rahner believe about those who have not heard the gospel?**

**Rahner believed only those who had not heard the gospel could be saved as 'anonymous Christians', while those who rejected it knowingly could not be.**

**What is the main theological question in religious pluralism?**

**The key question is whether Christ is the only way to salvation or if other paths are equally valid.**

**Pluralism can be seen as a response to the diversity of religious experiences and truths across cultures.**
