<b>Denomination</b>	<b>A branch or group within a religion (e.g. Catholic, Anglican, Methodist in Christianity).</b>
<b>Eternal</b>	<b>Without beginning or end; lasting forever.</b>
<b>Omniscient</b>	<b>All-knowing; God knows everything, past, present, and future.</b>
<b>Omnipotent</b>	<b>All-powerful; God can do anything that is possible.</b>

**Omnibenevolent**

**All-loving; God shows perfect goodness and love to everyone.**

**Monotheism**

**Belief in only one God.**

**Transcendent**

**God is beyond and outside the universe; not limited by the physical world.**

**Immanent**

**God is present and active within the world and human lives.**

**Trinity**

**The Christian belief that God is three persons in one: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.**

**Fundamentalist**

**Someone who believes religious texts should be taken literally, as the exact word of God.**

**Freewill**

**The ability to make choices independently, without being controlled.**

**Original sin**

**The idea that all humans are born with a tendency to sin, inherited from Adam and Eve.**

**The Fall**

**When Adam and Eve disobeyed God in the Garden of Eden, leading to sin entering the world.**

**Inconsistent triad**

**The idea that God cannot be all-powerful, all-loving, and allow evil to exist at the same time.**

**Moral evil**

**Suffering caused by humans doing wrong (e.g. murder, theft).**
