Messiah	The chosen one sent by God to save humanity (Christians believe this is Jesus).
Agape	Selfless, unconditional love; the kind of love Jesus taught and showed.
Great Commission	Jesus' command to his followers to spread his teachings to all nations.
Sermon on the Mount	Jesus' key teachings found in Matthew 5–7, including the Beatitudes.

Last Supper

Jesus' final meal with his disciples, where he shared bread and wine.

Eucharist

A Christian service remembering Jesus' death, using bread and wine (also called Holy Communion).

Resurrection

Jesus rising from the dead on the third day after his crucifixion.

Ascension

Jesus returning to heaven 40 days after his resurrection.

Salvation

Being saved from sin and its consequences; entering a right relationship with God.

Atonement

The belief that Jesus' death repaired the broken relationship between God and humans.

Parousia

The second coming of Christ at the end of time to judge the living and the dead.

Apocalyptic

Describing events linked to the end of the world or a revelation about God's plan.

Heaven

A place of eternal peace and being in God's presence after death.

Hell

A place of eternal separation from God, often linked to punishment after death.

Purgatory

(Catholic belief) A place or state where souls are purified before entering heaven.
