<b>Omniscient</b>	<b>All-knowing; God knows everything, past, present, and future.</b>
<b>Omnibenevolent</b>	<b>All-loving; God shows perfect goodness and love to all creation.</b>
<b>Immanent</b>	<b>God is present and active within the world and human lives.</b>

**Transcendent**

**God exists beyond and outside the universe; not limited by time or space.**

**Design Argument**

**The idea that the world's order and complexity suggest a designer (God).**

**Anthropic Principle**

**The universe appears fine-tuned for life, which suggests purpose or design.**

**Cosmological Argument**

**The belief that everything has a cause, so there must be a first cause (God).**

**Theory of Evolution**

**The scientific idea that life developed over time through natural selection.**

**Infinite Regress**

**A sequence of causes going back forever, with no first cause.**

**Moral Argument**

**The idea that our sense of right and wrong points to the existence of God.**

**Conscience**

**An inner sense of right and wrong that guides human actions.**

**Bonhoeffer**

**A Christian who opposed the Nazis, taught about costly discipleship, and was executed for resisting evil.**

**Ethical Living**

**Living according to moral principles, often based on religious teachings.**

**Sustainability**

**Using resources in a way that protects the environment for future generations.**
