



## **NATIONAL OFFER DAY 1 MARCH 2023**

### **Information for Year 7 Academic Year 2023/2024**

#### **1. What should I do if the local authority has offered a place to my child?**

If your child has been offered a place at CCHSG please do not contact us at this stage. The school will be writing to you within two to three weeks of National Offer Day asking you to complete and return our acceptance form.

#### **2. What should I do if my child has not been offered a place at CCHSG?**

If you did not get your preferred school, you will be added to the waiting lists of all schools that were ranked higher than the school offered in your application. You will be notified in writing if an offer is available. The waiting list is available online through Essex County Council from 21 March 2023.

#### **Before you can check a waiting list**

You will need your child's Essex Application Reference Number.

If you are an Essex resident, this can be found on your offer email or letter.

If you pay Council Tax to another authority, for example Redbridge, Hertfordshire, Havering, Southend-on-Sea or Thurrock, please call 0345 603 2200 to request your child's Essex Application Reference Number.

Essex County Council hold the waiting lists for all schools until 31 August 2023. You will be unable to contact Essex County Council until 21 March 2023 with regard to the waiting list. CCHSG will be unable to give you any information regarding waiting list positions until the list is passed from ECC to CCHSG in September 2023.

### **3. What should I do if my child has not had an opportunity to visit CCHSG?**

Tours are available to those parents/applicants who have not yet had the opportunity to visit CCHSG. The tours will be held on Wednesday 8 March, Thursday 9 March and Friday 10 March from 09:10 – 10:10. Please click the link below to book.

#### **2023/2024 Cut off Score**

### **5. What if I would like to change my choice of school?**

- Would like to apply for a school that you did not apply for originally
- Wish to be added to the waiting lists for a school that you named as a lower preference on your application than the school offered

You should not reject the school offer you have until you have secured another place.
